6. Comments of the Probate Court Administrator – Judge Knierim

The proposed changes to the Rules of Procedure were sent to all judges. Judge Knierim thanked the Committee for all of their hard work. The proposed changes will be sent to the Supreme Court for approval.

The online invoicing project for attorneys and conservators is progressing well. The pilot courts will start in January, 2017. The plan is to have the system in all courts by April, 2017.

PCA is working with OPM on several cost recovery ideas for conservatorships. First, to make conservator compensation eligible for payment under Title 19. Second, to establish a statutory lien on real property for conservator compensation. Third, to develop a state mechanism to recover conservator compensation paid by PCA when there is a windfall situation for the conserved person.

PCA is also working on procedures for collection of unpaid invoices.

Judge Knierim announced that Amy Benjamin, the former Chief Clerk for the Children's Courts, has been promoted to Manager of Support and Training. She will be working statewide to assist courts with efficiency, best practices and various other areas.
