Remarks by the Chair

Judge Knierim stated that the state budget process will begin in February when Governor-elect Lamont is expected to present his proposal for fiscal years 2019-20 and 2020-21. PCA will provide updates as the process moves forward.

Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Office Budgets

The committee discussed the office budget criteria for fiscal year 2019-20. Andrea King explained that the proposed guidelines are unchanged from the current fiscal year (see spreadsheet in the meeting materials).

Judge Marino made a motion to approve the office budget criteria as presented. Judge Anthony seconded the motion. Judge Knierim called for a vote and the motion passed.

After approval of office budget criteria, Judge Knierim asked the committee to consider eliminating the \$1,500 cap on PCA's authority to approve the transfer of funds within a court's budget to increase the amount available in the subscription category. The ability to exceed the cap would provide flexibility in dealing with one-time overages that occur when a publisher replaces a volume with a new edition.

Judge Anthony made a motion to authorize PCA to exceed the \$1,500 cap. Judge Marino seconded the motion. Judge Knierim called for a vote and the motion passed.
