- Instructions:**
- 1) If a conservator of the estate, or a fiduciary with equivalent authority, has been appointed in another state for an incapable person who is not domiciled in Connecticut, a family member of the conserved person or a conservator or guardian of the estate or person of the incapable person may use this form to petition for appointment of a conservator of the estate with authority over Connecticut real or tangible personal property owned by the conserved person.
 - 2) The petition, together with a certified copy of the appointment of a conservator of the estate in the state of the incapable person's domicile, must be filed in the court for the probate district in which the real or tangible personal property, in whole or in part, is situated. Also file Confidential Sheet, PC-3011CI, with the respondent's confidential social security number.
 - 3) Contact the court regarding payment of service of process fees.

 - 5) Type or print in ink. Use an additional sheet, or PC-180, if more space is needed.
