- 1) A conservator or guardian of an adult appointed by a court of another state in an involuntary proceeding may file this petition to request a provisional order of a Connecticut Probate Court to accept the transfer of the conservatorship from the other state under the Connecticut Uniform Adult Protective Proceedings Jurisdiction Act. The court will not issue a final order accepting the transfer unless the court receives a final order by the transferring court under provisions similar to those in C.G.S. section 45a-667q.
  - 2) Attach a certified copy of the original appointment of petitioner as conservator or guardian of an adult and a certified copy of the other state's provisional order of transfer to the State of Connecticut.
  - 3) For more information, see C.G.S. section 45a-667 et seq.
  - 4) Type or print in ink. Use an additional sheet, or PC-180, if more space is needed.
