I have been proposed/appointed to the position of trust in the above estate or matter.

I am a non-resident of Connecticut residing at the above address and hereby appoint the judge for the above probate district, and his or her successors in office, to be my agent upon whom all process may be served in any action or proceeding against me in my representative capacity and in any garnishment of the estate in my possession as fiduciary. I also appoint the probate judge to be my agent for service of all process in any action against me in my individual capacity founded upon or arising from my acts or omissions as fiduciary.

I hereby agree that any process served on the probate judge or his or her successors in office shall be of the same force and validity as if served upon me personally, subject to the applicable provisions of the statutes of Connecticut. This appointment shall continue in force as long as any liability remains outstanding against me as fiduciary and as long as the estate is in my possession as fiduciary.
