- 1) Any adult person may use this form to petition the court to appoint a guardian of a person who is unmarried and (a) at least 18 but less than 21 years of age, (b) dependent on a competent caregiver, (c) consents to the appointment or continuation of a guardian of the person after attaining age 18, and (d) is filing with this petition, or has previously filed, a Petition/Special Immigrant Juvenile Findings under 8 USC 1101, PC-609, pursuant to C.G.S. section 45a-608n. The unmarried person is defined as a "minor or minor child" under C.G.S. section 45a-616(f)(2).
 - 2) The petition shall be filed in the probate district in which the minor resides, is domiciled or is located at the time the petition is filed. Also file Confidential Sheet, PC-5013CI, with confidential social security numbers.
 - 3) Contact the court regarding payment of service of process fees and, if applicable, payment of newspaper notice publication.
 - 4) For more information, see C.G.S. sections 45a-608n, 45a-616 and 45a-617.
 - 5) Type or print in ink. Use an additional sheet, or PC-180, if more space is needed.
