- 1) An adult adopted person whose adoption was finalized prior to October 1, 1983, or such person's adult child or grandchild, may use this form to petition the court for an order directing the Department of Public Health to issue an uncertified copy of an original birth certificate to the petitioner. For the court to issue the order, **each** birth parent named on the original birth certificate must: a) have consented to the release of identifying information in accordance with C.G.S. sections 45a-751 to 45a-751b, b) be deceased, OR c) a legal representative or guardian ad litem for the birth parent must have consented to the release of identifying information in accordance with C.G.S. section 45a-753. If the adopted person is deceased, the petition may be filed by a biological parent, an adult biological sibling or an adult descendant of the adopted person. Supporting evidence should be filed with the petition.
- 2) The petition should be filed in the Probate Court that finalized the adoption or appointed a guardian ad litem in accordance with C.G.S. section 45a-753.
