Adoption of FY24 Office Budgets

Judge Anthony moved to approve the Probate Court budgets as presented which motion Judge Brandt seconded. After a call for a vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Compensation Plan Adjustment

Chair Streit-Kefalas turned over the meeting to Lisa Hansen, Director of Financial Services, who summarized the implementation of the January 2023 cost of living adjustment (COLA) for eligible employees.

Other Business

Chair Streit-Kefalas reported that the federal public health emergency due to COVID-19 is set to expire on May 11, 2023. She called for a motion to note the termination of Policy 903 effective May 11, 2023 to coincide with the end of the federal declaration of the public health emergency. Judge Brandt moved to terminate Policy 903 effective May 11, 2023 which motion Judge Anthony seconded. There was discussion that the policy had been utilized recently over the holidays but has since quieted down. After a call for a vote, the motion carried unanimously.
